Association Profile

NAEFO was formally organized in 2001 by the state association of Oregon, Washington, California and Montana. The organization was the result of years of collaborative meetings with elected and appointed officials from several western states who had banded together to work on issues at the regional and national level. Today, NAEFO has individual and state members ranging from California to New York.
