Candy McCullough, Incumbent President



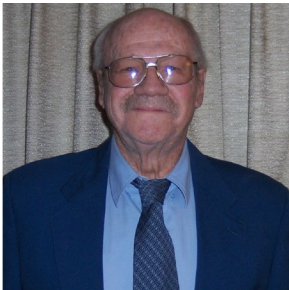

Robert (Bob) Skaggs, Incumbent Vice President



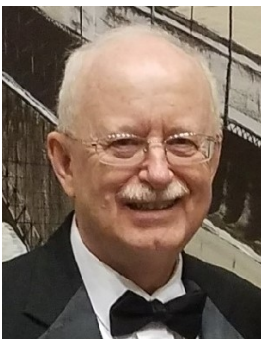
